Background

In 2007, the MAWIB was restructured to assume the lead role in transforming Milwaukee's local workforce development landscape. In response to the expanding needs of healthcare employers, MAWIB as adopted a sector-based approach to workforce solutions.

Vision

Developing our Health Sector Strategy, was based on partnering with a workforce intermediary with expertise and experience to establish a one-stop training institute to serve our goal of 1500 participants and where best practices for adult learning, career readiness, cohort support and technology-based, hybrid learning, and accelerated training models will be delivered. In addition, this institute will be responsive to employer needs.

Funding

- **DHHS, Administration for Children and Family Services**
- **Funding Award = \$3,401,260 (up to 4 continuation awards are possible, for a project period of 5 years based upon satisfactory performance.)**

Assessments & Career Readiness

Each participant referred to the CareerWorks HTI for training will receive the following assessments and will be assigned to a coach to develop IDP's and education/training strategies.

- Prove IT

CareerWorks HTI-Services Provided (cont.)

Training

- All training provided will be healthcare-specific training for entry, mid-skill and high-skilled positions.
- All training will be designed to target skills and competencies demanded by the healthcare industry.
- All training programs will be designed to result in an employer or industry recognized certificate or degree.
- Training will include technology-based, self-paced learning programs.

CareerWorks HTI – Services Provided (cont.)

- **All training will combine supportive services with education to help participants overcome barriers to employment**
- **All training will be provided at times that are easily accessible to targeted populations.**

CareerWorks HTI – Services Provided (cont.)

Referrals /Support Services – The YWCA will develop a process to request funding specified in the HPO Grant to provide the following support services to participants as needed and appropriate to insure successful participant achievements. Process will require pre-approval by MAWIB.

- Transportation
- Child Care
- Incentives
- Training Stipends
- Licenses
- Certification/Testing
- Other (as MAWIB approved)

CareerWorks HTI – Services Provided (cont.)

Employer Services

- The CareerWorks HTI will be a hub facility for healthcare employer recruitment, pre-screening activities and specialized job fairs.
- The CareerWorks HTI will provide for retention events such as financial literacy, resume workshops and work/life workshops.
- The CareerWorks HTI will provide for employer/partner meetings and other activities focused on enhancing career success of new healthcare employees.
